Italian F3 champion Riccardo Agostini joins MP for Auto GP season

Italian Formula 3 champion Riccardo Agostini will contest the 2013 Auto GP season with MP Motorsport.

The 18-year-old Italian triumphed in his maiden season in Italian F3, and was rewarded with a Ferrari Formula 1 test alongside runner-up Eddie Cheever at Vallelunga [in November last year](#).

Agostini, who also ran for Coloni in GP2's 2012 post-season [test at Barcelona](#), said he is targeting the 2013 Auto GP crown.



"My goal is to learn the car which is remarkably faster than in Formula 3, and fight to win a very tough championship with top teams and drivers," he said.

"I'm very satisfied with this deal with MP Motorsport, this will be a key experience in order to make a successful move to GP2.

"I want to thank Enzo Coloni for his trust and to have enabled me to join a top developmental series like Auto GP".
