



## POST-RACE QUOTES

### **TRENT HINDMAN (No. 1 Prestige Performance, winner, first Pro):**

"It was interesting. I saw what was going on out there in Riccardo's [Agostini] stint and he had a hell of a drive by the way. Just two awesome moves coming out of six. And that's where I was getting a little bit nervous on the pit wall seeing what was coming but at the end of the day the Prestige Performance/Wayne Taylor Racing guys gave us a fantastic car. Pit strategy was great. We were able to get out and get the lead and get clean air. That's where this car is the happiest. Big thanks to all the Prestige guys and big thanks to Riccardo for all his effort."

### **RICCARDO AGOSTINI(No. 1 Prestige Performance, winner, first Pro):**

"It's not exactly what I planned but anyway, I struggled a bit during the first three or four laps to get into the pace and after that I lost two positions, so I was running in P4. From there I tried to get into my pace and tried to get closer to the top three guys, so I wanted to be as close as possible to the lead before the pit window opened. And that's what happened and I am really, really happy about this weekend. Trent did an amazing job after the pit stop and we have the championship lead now and hopefully for the next race we are fighting for the victory."

### **AUSTIN VERSTEEG (No. 7 DXDT Racing, winner, first ProAm):**

"Unfortunately, we had a little bit of an issue in Race 1 yesterday and I have never been to Road America in this car in the dry, so besides 15 or 20 minutes of qualifying, the race was my first full session out on track. I can't thank everyone enough. Everyone who prepared me. Just going over data, and my engineer Jonatan Jorge and JJRD got my mindset correct heading into this race. As the race went on we were just learning as we went. Ritchie [Richard Antinucci] and I had an awesome battle at the end. It was just about gathering information and learning as we went on.
