Riccardo Agostini is set for the Italian GT challenge as the 2021 season starts this weekend at Monza.

The Italian racing driver, who turned 27 one week ago, returns to team Audi Sport Italia pairing with youngster Lorenzo Ferrari in a R8 LMS GT3 car to compete both in the Endurance and the Sprint series that kicks-off on Saturday.

Agostini, who was one of the front-runners in 2020 when he secured three victories at Misano and Mugello, has high expectation. The last year he finished second at Monza in the Endurance series and claimed a third and second position in the Sprint series event held on October.

With a strong 30-car grid, Monza is the first out of four Sprint series rounds and the first of eight Italian GT events. The two one-hour free practice sessions will get underway on Friday at 11.35 and 15.50. Qualifying one and two are scheduled on Saturday from 11.05. The first of two 50-minute plus one lap races will start at 17.50. Race 2 will commence on Sunday at 15.30.
